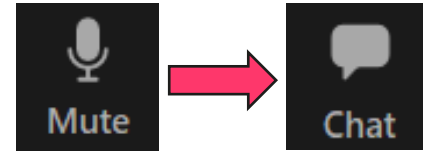

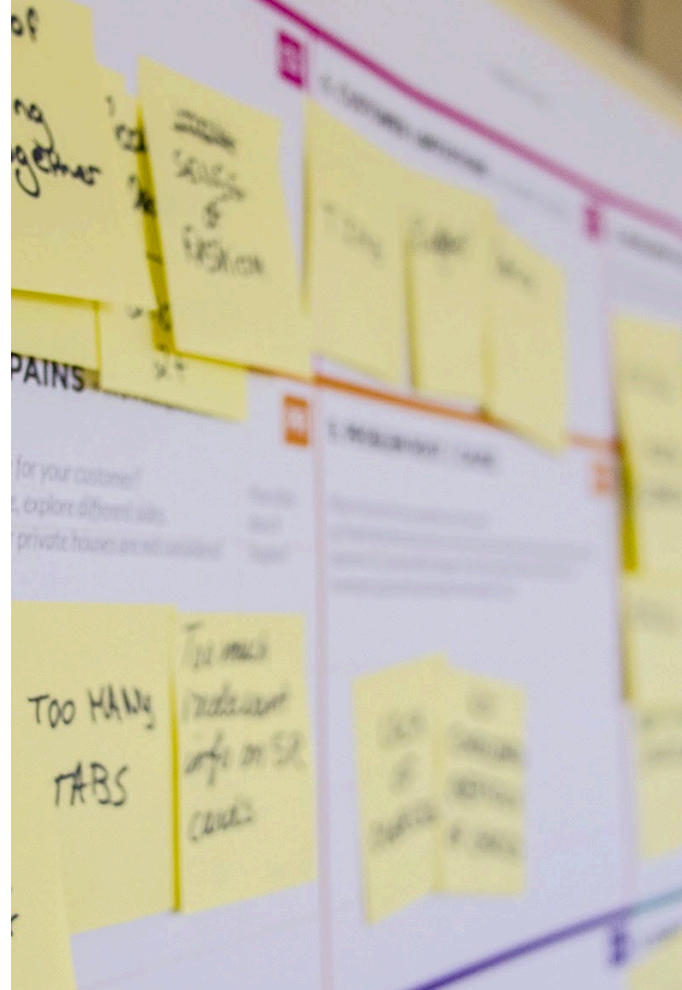

- **Timeline:** July 2020 – June 2021
- **Two main components:**

Take stock of first 10 years of the UNGPs (report to Human Rights Council)

Develop a vision and roadmap for global implementation over the next 10 years (launch in June 2021 for UNGPs@10 anniversary)

- Informed by **global multi-stakeholder consultation process & collaboration with partners**
- **Global call for input: see project webpage**
